- I agree that the dog is being adopted for myself and will not be sold, adopted, or given to another party. _____ (initial)

For Dogs 2nd Chance

Tips for switching dog foods:

Things You'll Need

- A measuring cup
- The old food
- The new food

- Cooked white rice and/or a tablespoon of canned pumpkin [not pie filling] may be added to the food to add in digestion.
- If the dog's stomach does get upset, a meal of rice and plain cooked chicken is recommended. Of course, remove any bones!
- If he or she continues to have diarrhea or throw up, discontinue the new food and contact your vet.

If possible, it's best to transition from wet food to wet, dry to dry, or mixture to mixture. The key is to keep the form of the food the same.

Switch the food gradually, over a period of a week or so. Start with a mixture of 25% new and 75% old and feed that for two or three days, then step it up to 50-50, and finally end up with a combo of 75% new, 25% old.

If you don't detect any changes in their digestion over the week's time, you can start feeding the new food exclusively. Congratulations!
